Reclaimed Hope Initiative (RHI) is a faith-based, family-centered support and advocacy organization that provides

rest, support, connection, healing, and hope to families navigating foster care, adoption, and children with disabilities.

RHI is a place for ALL families walking through trauma, crisis, and hardship—offering a safe haven to be seen, heard, and cared for through the darkest moments.



We use education, advocacy, mental health support, and racial mentorship to offer wrap-around services to every member of the family. Our services address the mental, physical, social, and recreational needs of a vulnerable population of families in Charlottesville City and Albemarle County. We also serve families in the Counties of Fluvanna, Louisa, Nelson, and Augusta. Since our launch in 2018, we have grown by over 1,300% in the number of families served

 Thrive aims to support and empower families, educate the community, and cultivate an environment that embraces race, culture, disability, and diversity.

RHI offers bi-weekly support groups, community resources, monthly respite events, inhome caregiving, IEP/Medicaid navigation, semi-annual day retreats, and a safe place to share the hardest parts of this journey.

- Camp Hope offers Equine-Assisted Therapy, Music Therapy, Art Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Mentorship, Nature Exploration, Sensory Experiences, De-escalation Spaces, and more!

Ramp: Racial Advocacy and Mentorship Program

- RAMP seeks to implement community change on the educational requirements of white foster and adoptive parents. This program aims to limit implicit bias and promote racial sensitivity while giving children of color a positive racial mirror to facilitate growth, education, and confidence.
- RAMP will promote racial inclusion, equity, healing, advocacy, and justice within each family and the greater community.
- RAMP offers same-race mentorship to youth ages 8-18
 who are transracially adopted or fostered by white parents
 and is in process of establishing an educational program
 developed for white parents adopting or fostering a child
 of color

The Farm Retreat

- The Farm Retreat is a vision to establish a year-round retreat center where families navigating foster care, adoption, and children with disabilities can find rest and receive respite from life's everyday challenges. It will proactively offer respite to limit the diagnosis of secondary traumatic stress or burnout in caregivers, improving quality of life and minimizing the need for extraneous medical care to meet basic human needs. At-risk youth and children with disabilities will have opportunities to build new friendships, stay active, learn new skills, promote teamwork, and improve their self-confidence, social skills, communication skills, and sense of belonging.

Identity Theft | November

 Identity Theft is an annual conference during National Adoption Month that works to "flip the script" and offer differing



- perspectives on difficult topics. The conference addresses loss, grief, race, and identity from the adoptee & foster youth perspective, with content coming directly from keynote speakers and panelists who offer first-hand experience from various backgrounds.
- Identity Theft offers two days of content one for professionals in the field, and one for parents/caregivers.
 Everyone is encouraged to come with an open mind, ready to listen and learn perspectives that will equip and empower us to better serve the mental, emotional, and racial needs of children navigating foster care or adoption at an earlier age.


